Sample Use Cases

- Work Group Managers
 - A manager of a complex project can listen to sub-contractors discussing the project, and supply summary advice to one group, without interrupting any other group.

• First Responders

- A manager of ten groups of fire fighters can listen to all ten groups and coordinate actions and resources.
- Mediators
 - A mediator can listen to two groups of people discuss an issue and suggest solutions, without each group speaking to the other.
